Job Title: General Construction Labor

Work Location: Durant, OK

Reports To: Production Supervisors

### Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Prepare modular and/or prefabricated buildings for shipment, using polyethylene sheets, nails and hammers.
- Install, repair, and replace units, fixtures, appliances, and other items and systems in modular and/or prefabricated building using hand tools or power tools.
- Inspect, examine, and test the operation of parts or systems to evaluate operating condition and to determine if adjustments are needed.
- Reset hardware, using chisels, mallets, and screwdrivers.
- Perform related duties as assigned by Supervisor
- Maintain compliance with all company policies and procedures

### Education and/or Work Experience Requirements:

- Knowledge of materials, methods, and the tools involved in the construction or repair of houses, buildings, or other structures such as modular or prefabricated structures.
- Possess knowledge of design techniques, tools, and principles involved in production of precision technical plans, blueprints, drawings, and models.
- Need knowledge of machines and tools, including their designs, uses, repair, and maintenance.
- Capable of determining the kind of tools and equipment that are required to perform a job.
- Give full attention to what other people are saying, taking time to understand the points being made, asking questions as appropriate & capable of adjusting actions in relation to others' actions.
- Install equipment, machines, wiring, or programs to meet specifications.
- Selects and uses training methods and procedures appropriate for the situation when learning or teaching new things.
- Workers with a passion for working with their hands to positively chip in at construction job sites.
- Familiar with duties of the construction field, along with the materials, tools and machinery used.
- Comfortable with working as part of a team, jointly carrying out assigned construction tasks.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Must be able to work under pressure and meet deadlines, while maintaining a positive attitude
- Ability to work independently, or with a team, and carry out assignments to completion within parameters of instructions given

### Physical Requirements:

- Ability to do physical labor and other strenuous physical tasks.
- Ability to lift, carry, push/pull, climb, kneel, squat, crawl, bend, reach.
- Ability to safely and successfully perform the essential job functions consistent with the ADA, FMLA and other federal, state and local standards, including meeting qualitative and/or quantitative productivity standards.
